

KS4 Qualifications Summary 2018-2019

Entry Level Certificates give basic knowledge and skills, they apply learning in everyday situations under direct guidance or supervision. The grades go from Entry level 1 (E1) up to Entry Level 3 (E3).

The level after Entry Level in the National Qualifications Framework is Level 1, which includes GCSE grades from 1 up to 3.

Level 2 qualifications include GCSE grades 4 to 9.
